### 19th International Engineering & Technology Fair 2011 (IETF)

10-12 February 2011, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, India

IETF – the Flagship Event of CII since 1975 – in its long journey has achieved the status of a comprehensive international B2B event in this part of the world. Segmented into well-defined technological sections of the engineering/manufacturing industry and services sector, a number of focused sector specific shows have been successfully organized as concurrent shows with IETF, over the years.

The 19th Edition of IETF hosted around 250 exhibitors spread in an area of 25000 sqmts, generated business enquiries worth Rs 1400 crores and 25,162 business visitors visited the fair with overseas business delegations from Japan, UAE, Singapore, Iran, UK and China.




IETF 2011 featured focused concurrent shows:

### India, UAE to increase trade volume

THE trade between India and United Arab Emirates (UAE) has grown 100 per cent in the last five years. Commerce and Industry Minister Anand Sharma today said that there is a lot of business and investment potential which can be further exploited to the mutual advantage of both the countries. In a meeting with Sheikhha Lubna Al Qasbi, Minister of Foreign Trade, UAE, Sharma said that UAE is the top-most trading partner of India representing about 60 per cent of India's export to the countries. 2009-10, "India-UAE Trade Policy Forum set up by the two countries to facilitate bilateral trade and investment needs to be further strengthened."

India to sign free trade pact with Japan on February 16

### India to sign free trade pact with Japan on February 16

New Delhi: India will sign a comprehensive trade pact with Japan on February 16. The pact would enable the country to reduce or eliminate duties on most of the goods and services. The country would also ink a free trade pact with Malaysia in the same week. On 16 February, we will be in Tokyo to formally sign the agreement and next day travel to Kuala Lumpur to sign the agreement with Malaysia. Commerce and Industry Minister Anand Sharma said at a function organised jointly by the ministry and CII here.




